### Judging Criteria

Teams will be judged on a scale from 1 to 10 in six categories:

Precision – Unified steps and synchronized movements.

Originality – Are your movements, themes and appearances original?

Clarity – Clearly spoken words. Stepping and clapping as a team and individually.

Uniforms – Unified costumes and/ or outfits.

Difficulty – The complexity of the routine.

**Audience Response** – Does your routine get the audience excited?

10 – Excellent!

8 – Very Good

6 – Good

4 – Fair

2 – Needs Improvement

### **Guidelines**

1. Teams are required to behave in an orderly manner, walking in hallways quietly with hands behind their backs at all times.
2. As members of step teams we all share a common interest, to ensure future step competitions we must demonstrate good sportsmanship toward one another and always show respect for each team.

3. *If a member of any team is found misbehaving (fighting, cursing, arguing, etc.) they will be escorted off of school grounds and their team will be disqualified from the competition.*
4. *All teams are required to attend with a Coach and Team Captain.*
5. *No provocative movements and steps.*
6. *No vulgar language on or off the stage. This includes language in any music used during performance. (please indicate whether music will be used in your performance)*
7. *Each team is required to check in at 5:30 pm, dressed and ready to step. During this time, we would like to make you familiar with the stage area and our school so that your team can perform to the best of their ability.*
8. *No gum chewing or facial piercing (i.e. nose, ear, etc.) will be allowed during performance or backstage.*
9. *Each routine is to be 10 minutes or less. Your team will be penalized two points for every minute over your allotted time.*

10. *Teams must be dressed in some type of uniform. Each uniform must be appropriate attire. Any provocative attire will lead to disqualification.*
  
11. *Family and friends are always welcome to give support, however please remind them to keep cheering appropriate. Fighting and aggressive behavior will result in the individuals being asked to leave.*
  
12. *Teams are responsible for any music they wish to include in their routine. This includes someone available to start and stop the song when necessary. A fault in timing may or may not result in point reduction.*
